North Hornell Volunteer Fire Department is looking for
a few good men and women for Volunteer Firefighters

There are 3 types of Firefighters

Interior Firefighter: Fully trained for interior of structure fire fighting operations

Exterior Firefighter: Driver, Pump Operator, Fire Police, exterior operations

Junior Firefighter

You are eligible for active membership in the North Hornell Volunteer fire Department if you meet the following criteria:

Be at least 16 years old for the Junior Program and 18 for the Interior and Exterior

Live or work in the North Hornell Protection District

May live outside the district, there are positions open

Be physically capable to perform the duties of the category in which you wish to serve
It generally takes an applicant 6 to 8 weeks to get you through the process of membership.

Additional Information

When you become a member, you will be fully trained by the North Hornell Fire Department Training Officers and New York State Fire Training Officers at various Drills and classes. You will have to take Fire Fighter I or Fire Fighter Scene Support depending again on what category you join. We offer First Aid, CPR and EMT training; you must take the EVOC course (Emergency Vehicle Operations Course) prior to driving trucks. There are many courses available to the member, there something for everyone. All courses are offered at no charge to the member.

The Department has an Auxiliary (the Auxiliary is open to both men and women) which raised funds for the department and assists at emergencies.

The Department has various social events we host or go to such as parades, picnics and firematics competitions.
